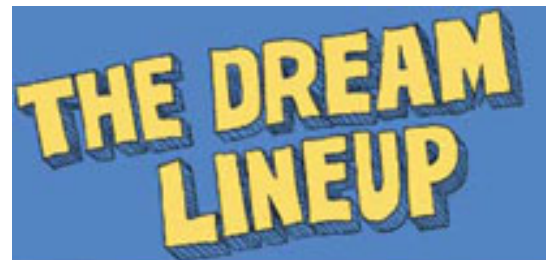

Multiple additions to the Logan Middle School building has created a maze for students, staff, parents, substitutes and community members to navigate through on a daily basis. The newly formed Renaissance Steering Committee thought a great way to assist people in finding their way would be to give each hallway a name. While that may have been the initial intent, the staff recognized that this was another way to "Renaissance" our building in a very visual manner.



The steering committee sent out an email to each of our units/departments and charged them with the task of coming up with a name for their hallway that would let everyone know who they were and what they were about. Submissions quickly came in and we approached a local sign company to make our street signs. Signs are 24" x 6" in size, made out of aluminum and reflect our school colors. Once the signs arrived our outstanding custodial crew went to work to get the signs up throughout the building.

Now when you enter Logan Middle School you will find the main office if you turn right on Panther Parkway East. If your first hour class is Physical Education then you need to turn left on Hero Heights, right on Positive Pathway, turn by Panther Café Ct. and head straight down Be Active Ave.

Need to get to music? Take the stairs to the second floor and travel down Good Vibrations Blvd until you hear choir singing or the band playing. Our sixth graders make the ascent to the third floor and find their classrooms are located on Determination Dr. or Discovery Rd..

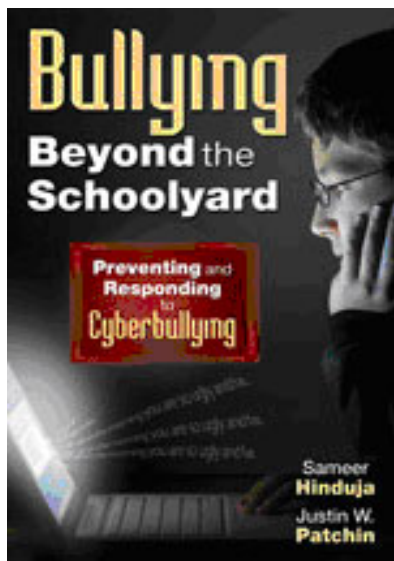
